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## Preface

Main points:

The strategy of global jihad is and has been very poorly understood by most people and agencies involved in defense and homeland security. The foundations go back decades and so do the failures of the US, UK and other governments to respond preventively, in particular with the entire history of relations and looking-the-other-way with respect to Pakistani based, initiated, and controlled nuclear proliferation.

The problem is far and away different today than it has ever been and must be understood in the context of fundamental jihadi strategies that are long-term and thus the role of WMD of any sort (including major cyberwarfare, also to be understood as WMD along with CBRNE) must be understood not in terms of a very low probability of an isolated near-term (2001 – present or in the next few years) attack, but in terms of extremely high probability future attacks that are not going to come in the manner or via the logistics for which the US, UK and others have been undergoing defense and security measures.

The relationship between coordinated and highly strategic WMD warfare with natural and economic Emergent Critical Processes (ECP) is explained in depth because this is so fundamental to the jihadi strategic plans.

The failures of Western defense and homeland security due to conventionalism, political cliques, exclusions, ostracism, and “cognitive xenophobia” are explored and these causal factors, linked principally to personal/group motives (corporate, political, personal) shown to be one of the major roots and sustaining sources of weakness in our security and defense against the measures being planned against our societies.

Unlike many other scholarly and journalistic works, this book is not just about “here is the problem” and “here is what x, y, and z did or did not do about it.” It is definitely not a

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journalistic tome and the challenge is to balance judicious facts, documentation, and credentials including technical arguments that are rarely presented (to date, in print) with relative ease in reading. The book offers concrete and scientifically well-grounded explanations and perhaps most importantly, realistic, economical, pragmatic solutions that can be implemented by wiser and more objective leaders and by ordinary civilians, starting virtually immediately and without the need for massive budgets or budget changes.

The book is focused upon “here we are, this is how really bad the situation came to be because of ignorance, arrogance, conceit, and plain ‘old-think’ behavior, and here is how we can get out of this mess in time, in spite of so many other pieces of the puzzle (like the Recession, the Energy crunch, Global Climate Change) being so well in place in favor of the jihadi strategists and tacticians. The book is not afraid to point out the problems caused for national and international security by both individuals and organizations aligned principally to profit and political motives at the cost of well-being and security for society, but it is not a diatribe but a set of practical, technically sound analyses and solutions, drawing upon (in great part) well-founded physics and maths including advanced architectures for WMD as well as jihadi strategic philosophy.

## Introduction

With respect to WMD and the Global Jihad, there is a growing lethal hole in the defense of our society and in particular that of the USA, Canada and Western Europe. In spite of many efforts including the development of very sophisticated and expensive technologies, in spite of massive clamp-downs on immigration and unrestricted movement of people and goods, in spite of massive protocols for inspection and investigation of shipments, the fundamental strategic plan for the effective and blitzkrieg-like use of WMD and cyberwarfare has been and is being ignored and in fact is being unconsciously (for the most part) aided and abetted by our own hierarchies and organizations that were created and funded for homeland security and national defense. We are moving like clockwork toward a phase in the Global Jihad that has been advocated, planned, and implemented in a very careful and methodical manner, years ago, allowed to proceed without restraint by the American government in particular, over a period of years and now decades, and for which there is apparently as little awareness, credence or natural fear (as there should be) as there was before the attacks on Pearl Harbor and the World Trade Center.

This extraordinary and unnecessary weakness rests not with any superiority or unique strength of the global al Qaeda but instead it sits squarely within our own ranks. We have allowed old-think politics and conventionalism to dominate and to close out the prospects of identifying and acting upon information and understanding that is different from the “party line.” Our problem today is less with jihadi terrorists than with individuals in our own ranks and institutions who are essentially robotlike and xenophobic in their thinking, acutely suffering from intellectual arrogance and conceit, and driven primarily by political dictums and financial motives. The unique combination of conventional old-think and imperialist-flavored neoconservatism has created a situation where the USA and many other target societies are more vulnerable today for WMD and cyberwarfare attacks that will not only kill thousands and likely millions but disrupt irrevocably our economic and social structures.

If I am wrong in my assessments, then we are lucky. If I am correct, then we have only ourselves to blame for not doing all we can to circumvent the situation from arising and developing further. If there are readers who will read attentively and with both open minds and strongly critical,

objective thinking, then we are in a very good position to do something about these problems and to change the situation in our favor.

We can neutralize the Global Jihad. We can prevent the sequences of events that have been planned and which are not our fate to endure. We can prevent the widespread use of nuclear and other WMD in the manner that is poised to take place in a few years – not today, not tomorrow, not even in 2009 or 2010 by the way – but only if we can change the way we are conducting our defensive response. To do so means making significant changes in the manner in which we communicate and share information among ourselves and in particular within the defense and security communities of our target nations. This change is both simple and challenging. It is simple because it does not require spending additional billions, nor embarking upon Don Quixote quests for new “magic pill” technologies, nor creating infringements upon civil rights, nor doing anything that is particularly an upheaval or disruption of budgets or human activities. The change is a major challenge because it means something of a revolution in management, and in two areas. First, the stranglehold upon national security and intelligence by major vested-interest corporate contractors must be broken. Booz-Allen Hamilton, Northrop Grumman, SAIC, CSC, and down the line – these are companies serving their profit interests first, our national and international interests second and, one may clearly argue, last. Second, the policies of misusing the basic principles of intelligence control, classification of data, and security in general must be cleaned up and totally reworked, because for years and now decades we have been allowing people inside our government to misuse these protocols and principles to exclude people and thinking that is challenging to the “party line” of those who are in control of the bureaucratic channels, thereby curtailing both strategic and tactical value that could very well be the lifesavers we need on all fronts in the real war against terror.
